1. The Fair Board reserves the right to decline any entry not of show quality. The Fair Board also reserves the right to cancel any event, contest or judging without notice at any time prior to the actual holding thereof without liability except for the return of any entry fee.
2. The decision of the judges shall be final in all cases. Exhibits are judged by the numerical system, i.e., 1st, 2nd, 3rd. The judge has the privilege of not giving a 1st place award if it is felt the top exhibit does not warrant it.
3. No exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the judging in any manner. Any such attempt will result in the forfeiture of any and all awards.
4. Entries must be made in strict compliance with the classes designated in the premium list. The Superintendent of the section will have the discretion to add or delete any class during the conduct of the Fair.
5. Entry tags and sheets will be provided.
6. Premium Awards will be presented to the exhibitor as soon as possible after the closing of the Fair.
7. Fair officials endeavor to protect exhibits but will not be held responsible for loss or damage. The Fair does not carry insurance on exhibits. Valuable exhibits should be insured by the exhibitor.
8. Entries are open to any resident of Maryland or the District of Columbia, unless specified otherwise.

Food Preservation

All canned goods must be canned according to U.S.D.A. methods for safe preservation of foods in the home. (Food preservation publications are available through the Cooperative Extension Service (301) 868-9401.) For safety reasons, canned goods preserved by other methods and/or in non-standard canning jars will not be accepted. Canned goods may be opened during judging.

Section 170: Preserves

Preserves can be made with one or more fruits. Fruit is whole or cut into large pieces and cooked in syrup until transparent, tender, and well plumped. The fruit retains its shape. The juice should be thick and syrupy and surround the fruit. Preserves must be processed in a water bath canner.
